

NOTICE OF CALL FOR BIDS

2011 SANITARY SEWER CURED-IN-PLACE PIPE (CIPP) PROJECT

Sealed bid proposals will be received by the City of Sedro-Woolley Public Works Department, 325 Metcalf Street, Sedro-Woolley, Washington, 98284 until **2:00 p.m., March 31, 2011**, at which time the bids will be opened and publicly read.

This contract provides for the rehabilitation of sanitary sewer mains by the installation of approximately 4,509 linear feet of Cured-In-Place Pipe (CIPP) within the City of Sedro-Woolley. The total length includes approximately 307 linear feet of 18-inch CIPP and 4,202 linear feet of 8-inch CIPP. The work consists of cleaning, CCTV, removing indicated side sewer taps that protrude into the main by non-excavation methods, providing and installing CIPP and re-opening of indicated side sewer service lines by non-excavation methods, traffic control, erosion control, and cleanup.

Bid documents may be reviewed and purchased at the City of Sedro-Woolley Public Works Department, 325 Metcalf Street, Sedro-Woolley. A non-refundable fee of **\$65** will be charged for each set of bid documents (includes shipping). Checks should be made payable to the City of Sedro-Woolley and mailed to the Public Works Department, 325 Metcalf Street, Sedro-Woolley, WA 98284. The Bid Documents and addenda are also available on-line at www.ci.sedro-woolley.wa.us/BidsAwards/main. Contractors who download these Bid Documents are responsible for insuring that they are added to the plan holder's list in order to receive any issued addenda. All work shall be done in accordance with the Special Provisions of the Bid Documents, the 2010 WSDOT Standard Specifications for Road, Bridge, and Municipal Construction, including the amendments thereto, City Standards and other referenced documents.

All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check, or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of such bid proposal. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the City of Sedro-Woolley.

A non-mandatory pre-bid meeting scheduled for **March 23, 2011, at 10:00 a.m.** will be held for all prospective bidders. The pre-bid meeting will begin at the City of Sedro-Woolley City Hall Council Chambers, 325 Metcalf Street, Sedro-Woolley, Washington and will include a walk through at the project site.

The City of Sedro-Woolley is an Equal Opportunity and Affirmative Action Employer. Small, Minority- and Women-Owned firms are encouraged to submit bids.

The City of Sedro-Woolley reserves the right to accept a proposal of the bidder submitting the lowest responsible bid, to reject any or all bids, revise or cancel the work to be performed, or do the work otherwise, if the best interest of the City is served thereby.
