

INVITATION FOR BID
CITY OF SEDRO-WOOLLEY
SR20, METCALF TO TOWNSHIP
LANE WIDENING AND BICYCLE/PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS
PROJECT

Sealed bid proposals will be received by the City of Sedro-Woolley, at Sedro-Woolley City Hall, 325 Metcalf Street, Sedro-Woolley, Washington, 98284, (360) 855-0771, until 2:00 p.m. on June 21, 2011, and will then and there be opened and publicly read for roadway improvements along State Route 20 (SR 20) from mile post 65.38 to mile post 66.00 in Sedro-Woolley, Washington.

This work shall include but is not limited to widening SR 20 through the project limits to allow for a two-way left turn lane, curb, gutter, sidewalk, combined use path, storm water drainage facilities, sanitary sewer rehabilitation work, water line replacement, emergency traffic signal, Hawk pedestrian signal, and channelization throughout the project limits. All work shall be performed in accordance with the Contract Plans, Special Provisions, the Standard Specifications and Standard Plans. All materials, equipment, labor, and other miscellaneous items required to complete the work, shall be furnished by the contractor.

All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check, or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of such bid proposal. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance bond and payment bond both in an amount of 100 percent (100%) of the contract price within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the City of Sedro-Woolley. All bidders shall have a contractor's license to work in the State of Washington. Upon award, the successful bidder and subcontractors shall obtain or provide proof of holding a current *City of Sedro-Woolley Business License*.

Maps, plans, and specifications may be obtained from the City of Sedro-Woolley Engineering Department upon payment in the non-refundable amount of **\$50.00** for specifications and plan sets. If requesting that plans and specification be express shipped, add **\$16.00** to payment. Plans and Specifications will be available on **June 3rd, after 3:00 p.m. at the City of Sedro-Woolley Engineering Department, 325 Metcalf Street, Sedro-Woolley, Washington, 98284.**

Informational copies of maps, plans and specifications will be on file for inspection at the City of Sedro-Woolley Engineering Department, 325 Metcalf Street, Sedro-Woolley, Washington 98284.
