

**INVITATION FOR BID**  
**CITY OF SEDRO-WOOLLEY**  
**SR 9 TOWNSHIP TRENCHLESS SANITARY SEWER**  
**IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

Sealed bid proposals will be received by the City of Sedro-Woolley, at Sedro-Woolley City Hall, 325 Metcalf Street, Sedro-Woolley, Washington, 98284, (360) 855-0771, until **10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, July 2, 2008**, and will then and there be opened and publicly read for improvements of approximately 4550 lineal feet of sanitary sewer trunk main within portions of Township Street and State Route (SR) 9 using guided pilot tube microtunneling (GPTMT), horizontal directional drilling (HDD), and open-cut methods.

This project includes, the installation of Vitrified Clay or Polymer Mortar pipe and High Density Polyethylene (HDPE) Pipe utilizing trenchless methods for installation, installation of Polyvinyl Chloride (PVC) pipe, Manholes, side sewers, storm sewer pipe, catch basins; Waterline, Curb, Gutter, and sidewalk; the removal or abandonment of Manholes, sewer pipe, and catch basins; sawcutting asphalt concrete (ACP) pavement and Portland Cement Concrete (PCC); placement of gravel base and crushed surfacing top course, and pavement repair. All materials, equipment, labor, and all other miscellaneous items required to complete the work. All materials, equipment, labor, and other miscellaneous items required to complete the work shall be furnished by the contractor.

All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check, or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of such bid proposal. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance bond and payment bond both in an amount of 100 percent (100%) of the contract price within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the City of Sedro-Woolley. All bidders and subcontractors shall have a contractor's license to work in the State of Washington and a *City of Sedro-Woolley Business License*.

Maps, plans, and specifications may be obtained from the Sedro-Woolley City Hall upon payment in the amount of **\$35.00** for specifications and plan sets. If shipping is requested, an additional **\$10.00** is required to cover shipping costs. Plans and Specifications will be available on **June 11, 2008, after 3:00 p.m.** Informational copies of maps, plans and specifications are on file for inspection in the Sedro-Woolley City Hall, 325 Metcalf Street, Sedro-Woolley, Washington 98284.
