SR20, Metcalf to Township Lane Widening & Bicycle/Pedestrian Improvements Project

NOTICE OF UPCOMING DETOUR AND TEMPORARY NO PARKING ZONE

September 20, 2011

Dear Puget Avenue Resident,

As you are aware, we are in the midst of construction work on the SR20, Metcalf to Township Lane Widening & Bicycle/Pedestrian Improvements Project. During the period September 26 through October 14, 2011, SR20/Moore Street will be closed to through traffic from the east leg of the Patrick Street Roundabout east to Puget Avenue to allow for construction in the vicinity of the Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railroad bridge.

During this period, SR20 through traffic will be detoured through downtown Sedro-Woolley via the SR20/Ferry Street intersection to Ferry Street and Puget Avenue, returning to SR20 at the Puget Avenue intersection. This closure is expected to last up to three weeks as Interwest Construction Inc. re-grades and repaves SR20 in the BNSF trestle area, and connects sidewalks adjacent to SR20 from Patrick Street to Metcalf Street.

Due to the volume of traffic expected to use the detour, a no parking zone will be in effect on both sides of Puget Avenue from Ferry Street to SR20/Moore Street during the detour. No parking signs will be posted and no parking will be enforced beginning at 6 am on September 26, 2011. Please arrange to park your vehicles on your property during this period. Vehicles not removed prior to this time will be towed at the owner's expense.
