

WHAT TO RECYCLE

BOTTLES AND CANS

#1 PETE Plastic Bottles & Jars

Pop & liquor bottles and jars with #1 on bottom. **Remove & discard lids. Rinse clean. Flatten beverage bottles.** No microwave trays, deli trays, dairy containers, drinking cups, toys, Styrofoam or plastic bags.

#2 HDPE Plastic Jugs

Milk jugs, water bottles and other milk-colored plastic with #2 on bottom. **Remove & discard lids. Rinse clean. Flatten bottles.** No solid-colored #2 HDPE plastics or motor oil containers.

Glass Bottles & Jars

All colors accepted. Labels OK. **Remove & discard lids. Rinse clean. Avoid breaking glass.** No window glass, windshields, Pyrex, light bulbs, mirrors or ceramics.

Aluminum Cans & Foil

Rinse clean, Flatten cans & foil products. No oil filters, air filters or aerosol cans.

Tin Cans

Rinse clean, Remove paper labels (recycle with mixed paper). Flatten cans. No paint or chemical cans. No scrap metal.

MIXED PAPER

Old mail, magazines, catalogs, stationery, envelopes, computer, fax, copy and notebook paper, paper labels, cartons, and bags, shoe & cereal boxes (discard liner & flatten).

If windy, use a paper bag to secure top layer of papers.

No paper towels, plates, napkins, wax or plastic-coated papers (i.e. milk, juice or frozen food containers), plastic, foil, tissue or carbon paper.

NEWSPAPER

Clean newsprint, inserts and ads. **If windy, use a paper bag to secure top layer of papers.** No plastic delivery bags or rubber bands.

CARDBOARD

Remove packing materials and excess staples or tape. **Flatten and set next to bins.** No Styrofoam, plastic packing or wax-coated boxes.

Remember! Set out full bins by 6AM on collection day.

RECYCLING REMINDERS

- ? Please keep paper products separate. Do not mix paper with cans.
- ? Please set out full bins by 6AM on collection day. If your bins were out by 6AM but we missed you, please call the next morning for pick-up 360-757-4068

BOTTLES & CANS

- ? Please put extra bottles and cans in a paper bag and set out with full bin.
- ? Please rinse clean all bottles, jars and cans.
- ? Please remove paper labels (recycle with mixed paper).
- ? Please fatten all larger plastic bottles, aluminum cans, tin cans and foil products.
- ? Please remove and discard all metal lids, plastic caps, lids, rings and pumps.
- ? This type of glass is not recyclable. Please dispose of it with your trash.

- ? This metal product is not recyclable. Please dispose of it with your trash.

Oil Filter **Air Filter** **Aerosol Can**

- ? We cannot accept this type of plastic.

NEWSPAPER

- ? Please put extra newspaper in a paper bag and set out with full bin.
- ? Plastic delivery bag and rubber bands cannot be recycled.
- ? Please recycle mixed paper separately from newspaper.

MIXED PAPER

- ? Please put extra paper in a paper bag and set out with full bin.
- ? This type of paper is not recyclable. Please dispose of it with your trash.

Foil Paper Wax or Plastic-coated Paper**

- ? Please recycle newspaper separately from mixed paper.

CARDBOARD

- ? Please flatten all cardboard
- ? Waxed or soiled cardboard is not recyclable.
